The City of Waterloo secured an energy grant on behalf of the Morrison-Talbott Library. While insulation is being installed in the attic, the building must be unoccupied. No one, including the library staff, will be allowed in the building. As a result, the library will be closed from January 16th – January 21st, 2012, and again from February 13th – 18th, 2012. During those two weeks, all programs will be cancelled.
