Dear W.H.S. Student/Guardian:

Welcome to the 2017/2018 school year! In preparation for registration, please read all of the information below to assist you with the registration process. This year, we are offering online registration beginning on July 1st, 2017. We highly encourage you to take advantage of the online registration. For those of you that would prefer to come in for registration, the dates and times for this year's registration are below.

Online Registration is open from July 1st – July 10th 2017

Online Registration: In order to register online, please log into your Skyward account. Registration will be found on your homepage in Skyward. The link can be found on the district website.

Walk In Registration: We will have staff available to assist parents/guardians with online registration. While you are more than welcome, it is not necessary to report to the high school if you registered online prior to our registration dates.

Medication: Any student needing to take any type of medication or inhaler **MUST** have the "Medical Dispensation" form signed by the parent/guardian and a doctor. A new form is required every school year. Students are **NOT ALLOWED** to keep medication in their locker or carry it with them. The only exceptions are an inhaler or epinephrine auto-injector, which has been **authorized by a doctor** for students to carry with them.

Freshmen: All freshmen are required to have a new physical and up-to-date immunizations before the first day of school on August 16th. Freshmen are required to show proof of 2 doses of the Varicella Vaccine. Please bring your completed health form to the main office, Monday-Thursday, 8:00-3:00 prior to the first day of school or you may bring it to the designated registration day. (Note: the sports physical does NOT meet the requirements of the freshman physical however, the freshman physical **DOES** meet the requirements of the sports physical). As stated in the 2017/2018 Student Handbook- **failure to comply with the above requirements by the first day of school of the current school year will result in the child's exclusion from school until the required health forms are presented to the district.**

Freshmen Orientation: Freshmen/New Student Orientation meeting will be held on August 14th at 6:00 p.m. in the auditorium.

Seniors:

- You **MUST** have your picture taken with Lifetouch to have your photo in the yearbook and on the Composite Picture. Lifetouch will be here on Monday, July 10th during registration hours only. They will be located on the upstairs bridge. For questions concerning senior pictures, please call Lifetouch at 618-288-7896. Ids will be handed out on August 19th.

- Per the Illinois Department of Public Health, all seniors will be required to show proof of a recent meningococcal conjugate vaccination (MCV). All 12th graders must show proof of receiving two doses unless the first dose was administered after 16 years of age.

Parking: Any student driving a car to school will be issued a **new** parking tag. To receive your parking sticker, you **MUST** fill out the “parking permit” form. All students who intend to drive a vehicle to school **MUST** complete this process and park only in their assigned space.

Parking Tag: In order to receive your parking tag, please bring a copy of your paid receipt to registration. Parking spots will be issued on a first come, first serve basis

Locks: In order to receive your lock, please bring in a copy of your paid receipt into the main office Monday-Thursday, 8:00-3:00 prior to the first day of school or you may bring it on the designated registration day.

Athletes: There will be a mandatory meeting for all Fall Athletes and Parents on Monday, July 24th at 7:00 p.m. in the auditorium. For athletic information, updates & schedules, please visit www.waterloohighschool.weebly.com

Lock Fee (mandatory)	\$7.00 All students must have a lock for their hall locker. Freshman may use their lock from the Jr. High Sophomores/Juniors/Seniors may use last year’s lock.
Student I.D. fee (mandatory)	\$5.00 Freshmen/Sophomores/Juniors will have I.D. photo taken on August 18 th
PE clothes	Prices Vary. Any student taking PE/Weights MUST purchase P.E. clothing. Previous high school PE uniforms may be worn.

Driver’s Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$20.00 Classroom fee- Check payable to the State of Illinois. Fees will be collected when classes start. \$200.00 Behind-the-wheel fee- Check payable to WHS (may be paid at registration but MUST be paid prior to students driving with the instructor if your student is currently 16 or turns 16 during the 2017/2018 school year.
